If you can cover a part of this period, please sign the sheet on the notice board at the back of church. On Good Friday, we contemplate the Passion of the Lord, and centre our prayer on His death for us. The next evening, on Holy Saturday, I invite you to join us for a vigil of prayer and readings as we prepare for the First Mass of Easter and proclaim Christ as our Risen Lord. Our Mass on Sunday morning is at the usual time when we celebrate the Resurrection with joy and thanksgiving.
